## OBJECTIVE

Provide an ample amount of natural daylight from Solatube's Tubular Daylighting Devices to the interior footprint of the Service Shop.

## BACKGROUND

Goree Architects began designing a project for Lincoln's latest image program while utilizing Solatube as an effective solution to harvest free daylight. Griesenbeck was involved in the design process to specify a Solatube SkyVault configuration to prevent the hindrance of shadows cast onto the domes by rooftop mechanical equipment and screening.
